NHS waste disposal legislation

Health Sector organisations have an obligation to comply with the Environmental Protection Act 1990 and other associated legislation including the Hazardous Waste Regulations 2005.

The Department of Health best practice guide for the management of healthcare waste states that arrangements for managing healthcare waste need to be part of an employer's overall health and safety management system. Guidelines also state that appropriate records of "validation, calibration and monitoring" should also be kept.

Waste audits

Healthcare organisations and individual workers have a legal and moral duty to dispose of waste correctly and in accordance with statutory 'duty of care' requirements.

Waste audits are a legal requirement and play an essential role in demonstrating compliance with regulatory standards. Regular audits are recommended to enable line managers to monitor the effectiveness of processes such as waste segregation and waste minimisation initiatives

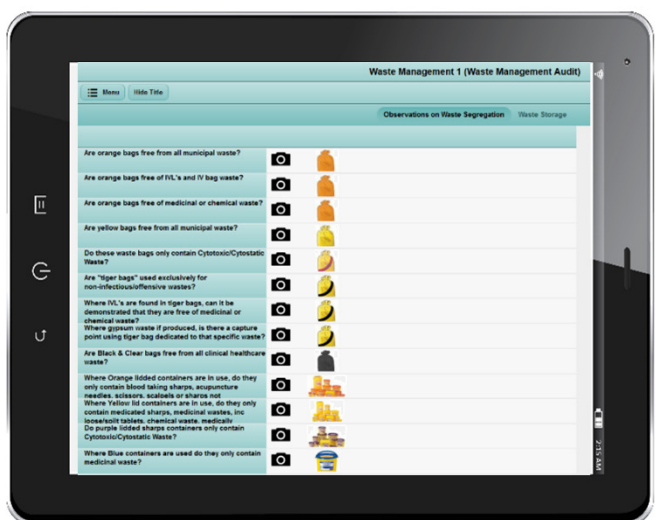
- Waste classification/segregation


